

Working on Domestic Gas Cookers in Commercial and Educational Premises

Whilst the gas technology involved in domestic gas cookers is no different than that in commercial ranges, in addition to ComCat 1 it has always been necessary to have ACS Accreditation CKR1 to be able to work on domestic cookers.

Following discussions with Energy Utility Skills who control the content of ACS Assessments, I am delighted to say that as from the 29th of April 2024, ComCat 1 assessments will include domestic cookers and it will no longer be necessary to have CKR1.

Many engineers may have current ComCat 1 accreditations that were assessed before the 29th of April 2024 and in these cases they will not have been assessed for domestic cookers so will still require CKR1 to work on them until such time they are reassessed for ComCat 1.
